LAS VEGAS – Systech, Inc. and CenApps Technologies (owners and developers of the ScheduleCom driver scheduling system) announce the ready mix industry's first fully integrated, web-based driver management and scheduling system.

Integra Driver Management greatly simplifies the process of establishing the daily schedule for drivers, publishing that schedule and managing driver hours. With complete integration to Systech's Integra Dispatch software module, this exciting new management tool automatically calculates driver requirements for each day, based upon the actual order requirements, while also facilitating unassigned driver scheduling.

Additionally, Integra Driver Management includes an optional hours-of-service rule set that can be user defined to highlight or limit the number of hours each driver can be in service within a given time period. Via its integration with Integra Dispatch, this new Integra module can keep a running total of the hours that each driver has been utilized through dispatch and apply the appropriate rule set to insure conformance with the local or federal hours-of-service rules.

The system generates voice messages for each driver as the schedule is created. Drivers access their message via '800' telephone number and their PIN. Operators know which drivers checked their message and when.

"As a web-based product, there's no computer, telephone or voice recording hardware to purchase or install locally," explained John Rabchuk, president of Systech. "This makes Integra Driver Management a very efficient and effective tool to bring greater efficiency to operations, with minimal start-up costs or effort. "

Integra Driver Management utilizes the driver, location, time card, ticket history and vehicle master information within Integra Dispatch. "This eliminates data replication, automates the initial set-up, and insures that the scheduling system is always current with all of the other Integra modules," Rabchuk added. No long-term contracts are required. A low monthly usage fee is based on actual number of drivers scheduled.

A manual mode is also available for utilizing the software without web-site integration for telephony purposes.
